

Suggestions for Printing or Copying the Overview Brochure

Paper

Please use cream/ivory color paper if possible. This gives a more professional look to the brochure rather than using white paper that makes the brochure look more like a photocopy.

Multiple Copies:

Best Solution for Multiple Copies

If you are making copies at Staples or other stationery supply store, if you can, give them the PDF on a flash drive so that they can print directly from the file. The photos and type come out the best with this method. Staples, etc., can also machine fold for a minimal cost.

Alternative Solution for Multiple Copies

Next best is to print the brochure out first on a laser printer rather than an ink jet printer. Then, when you go to make photocopies, the photos will print out more clearly (with halftone dots).

Single or Low Volume Copies:

Ink Jet Printer
